In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the Governor is pleased to make the following rules with a view to amending the Uttar Pradesh Deputy Superintendent of Police (Ministerial) Service Rules, 1993.

THE UTTAR PRADESH DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE  
(MINISTERIAL) SERVICE (SECOND AMENDMENT) RULES, 2016

Short title and commencement

1. (1) These rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh Deputy Superintendent of Police (Ministerial) Service (Second Amendment) Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

Amendment of rule 4

2. In the Uttar Pradesh Deputy Superintendent of Police (Ministerial) Service Rules, 1993, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, in rule 4, *for* existing sub-rule (2) set out in Column-1 below, the sub-rule as set out in Column-2 shall be *substituted*, namely:-

(2) The strength of the service shall, until orders varying the same are passed under sub-rule (1) be as given below:-

**Source of recruitment**

5. Recruitment to the post in the Service shall be made by promotion from the following sources:-

(i) Sixty seven per cent posts from amongst substantively appointed Inspectors (Ministerial) (Office Superintendent Branch);

(ii) Thirty three per cent posts from amongst substantively appointed Inspectors (Ministerial) (Confidential Assistant Branch/Short hand Reporter Branch).

**Source of recruitment**

5. Recruitment to the various categories of posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Ministerial) shall be made from the following sources:-

(i) Deputy Superintendent of Police (Ministerial) (Clerical Branch) - By promotion from amongst substantively appointed Inspectors (Clerical Branch);

(ii) Deputy Superintendent of Police (Ministerial) (Accounts Branch) - By promotion from amongst substantively appointed Inspectors (Accounts Branch);

4. In the said rules, in rule 8, for existing sub-rule (1) set out in Column-1 below, the sub-rule as set out in Column-2 shall be *substituted*, namely :-

(1) Recruitment by promotion shall be made on the basis of seniority subject to the rejection of unfit through the Selection Committee comprising:-

(i) Principal Secretary or Secretary, as the case may be, to the Government in Home Department - *Chairman*

(ii) Secretary to the Government in Karmik Department or his nominee not below the rank of Joint Secretary - *Member*

(iii) Director General of Police Uttar Pradesh - *Member*

(iv) Deputy Inspector General of Police (Administration), Uttar Pradesh - *Member*

COLUMN-2*Sub-rule as hereby substituted*

(1) Recruitment by promotion shall be made on the basis of the criterion on laid down in the Uttar Pradesh Government Servants Criterion for Recruitment by Promotion Rules, 1994, as amended from time to time, through the Selection Committee comprising:-

(i) Principal Secretary or Secretary, as the case may be, to the Government in Home Department - *Chairman*

(ii) Principal Secretary or Secretary, as the case may be, to the Government in Karmik Department or his nominee not below the rank of Joint Secretary - *Member*

(iii) Director General of Police, Uttar Pradesh - *Member*

(iv) Deputy Inspector General of Police (Administration), Uttar Pradesh - *Member*

NOTE - Nomination of officers for giving representation to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes of Citizens in the Selection Committee shall be made in accordance with the order made under section 7 of the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes) Act, 1994, as amended from time to time.

Amendment of  
rule 10

5. In the said rules, for existing rule-10, set out in Column-1 below, the rule as set out in Column-2 shall be *substituted*, namely :-

COLUMN-1*Existing rule*

**Probation 10.** (1) A person on substantive appointment to a post in the service shall be placed on probation for a period of one year.

(2) The appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded, extend the period

COLUMN-2*Rule as hereby substituted*

**Probation 10.** (1) A person on substantive appointment to a post in the service shall be placed on probation in accordance with the Uttar Pradesh Government Servants Probation Rules, 2013, as amended from time to time.

(2) If it appears to the appointing authority at any time during or at the

of probation in individual case specifying the date up to which the extension is granted:

Provided that, save in exceptional circumstances, the period of probation shall not be extended beyond one year and in no circumstances beyond two years.

(3) If it appears to the appointing authority any time during or at the end of the period of probation or extended period of probation that a probationer has not made sufficient use of his opportunities or has otherwise failed to give satisfaction he, may be reverted to his substantive post.

(4) A probationer who is reverted under sub-rule (3) shall not be entitled to any compensation.

(5) The appointing authority may allow continuous service, rendered on a post included in the cadre or any other equivalent or higher post to be taken into account for the purpose of computing the period of probation.

6. In the said rules, for existing rule 13, set out in Column-1 below, the rule as set out in Column-2 shall be substituted, namely :-

**Scale of pay 13.** (1) The scale of pay admissible to persons appointed to the posts in the Service, whether in a substantive or officiating capacity, shall be such as may be determined by the Government from time to time.
