

IN pursuance of the provisions of clause (3) of Article 348 of the Constitution, the Governor is pleased to order the publication of the following English translation of notification no. 8/2016 /609/6-pu-01-16-1300(7)-1994, dated March 15, 2016:

IN exercise of the powers under section 15 of the United Provinces Pradeshih Armed Constabulary Act, 1948 and all other power enabling him in this behalf, the Governor is pleased to make the following rules with a view to amending the Uttar Pradesh Police Radio Subordinate Service Rules, 2015.

THE UTTAR PRADESH POLICE RADIO SUBORDINATE SERVICE
(FIRST AMENDMENT) RULES, 2016

Short title and commencement

1. (1) These rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh Police Radio Subordinate Service (First Amendment) Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in the *Gazette*.

Amendment of rule 5

2. In the Uttar Pradesh Police Radio Subordinate Service Rules, 2015, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, in rule 5 for clauses (b), (c), (d) and (e) set out in Column-I below, the clauses as set out in Column-II shall be *substituted*, namely:-

COLUMN-I

Existing clauses

(b) Assistant Operator-

(ii) 10 percent of the posts shall be filled by recruitment through promotion by the Board on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit from amongst substantively appointed permanent Workshop Hands, who have successfully obtained Basic Training course for Assistant Operator and have completed five years of satisfactory service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period.

(c) Head Operator/Head Operator (Mechanic)-

(i) 50 percent of the posts shall be filled by direct recruitment by the Board.

COLUMN-II

Clauses as hereby substituted

(b) Assistant Operator-

(ii) 10 percent of the posts shall be filled by recruitment through promotion by the Board on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit from amongst substantively appointed permanent Workshop Hands, who have passed the Operator Training course Grade-III and have completed five years of satisfactory service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period.

(c) Head Operator/Head Operator (Mechanic)-

(i) 50 percent vacancies of the posts shall be filled by direct recruitment by the Board.

COLUMN-I

Existing Clauses

(ii) 50 per cent of the posts shall be filled by recruitment through promotion on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit from amongst substantively appointed permanent Assistant Operators, who have successfully passed Training Course for Head Operator/Head Operator (Mechanic) and have completed eight years of satisfactory service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period.

(d) Radio Sub-Inspector-

Hundred percent of the total number of sanctioned posts of Radio Sub-Inspector shall be filled by recruitment through promotion by the Board on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit, from amongst substantively appointed permanent Head Operator/Head Operator (Mechanic) who have passed Radio Sub-Inspector Course and have completed ten years of satisfactory service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period.

(e) Radio Inspector-

Hundred percent of the total number of sanctioned posts of Radio Inspector shall be filled by recruitment through promotion by the Board on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit, from amongst substantively appointed Radio Sub-Inspector who have passed Radio Maintenance Course and have completed five years of satisfactory service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period.

COLUMN-II

Clauses as hereby substituted

(ii) 50 per cent vacancies of the posts shall be filled by recruitment through promotion on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit from amongst substantively appointed permanent Assistant Operators, who have passed the Operator Training course Grade-II and have completed eight years of satisfactory service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period.

(d) Radio Sub-Inspector-

Hundred percent of the total number of sanctioned posts of Radio Sub-Inspector shall be filled by recruitment through promotion by the Board on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit, from amongst substantively appointed permanent Head Operator/Head Operator (Mechanic) who have passed the Operator Training course Grade-I and have completed ten years of satisfactory service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period.

(e) Radio Inspector-

Hundred percent of the total number of sanctioned posts of Radio Inspector shall be filled by recruitment through promotion by the Board on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit, from amongst substantively appointed Radio Sub-Inspector who have passed the Radio Sub Inspector or Radio Station Officer or Radio Maintenance Officer Training course and have completed five years of satisfactory service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period.

3. In the said rules, for existing rule-14 set out in Column-I below, the rule as set out in Column-II shall be *substituted*, namely:-

Amendment of rule 14

COLUMN-I

Existing Rule

14. The appointing authority shall determine and intimate to the Head of Department the number of vacancies to be filled during the course of the year of recruitment as also the number of vacancies to be reserved for candidates

COLUMN-II

Rule as hereby substituted

14. The appointing authority shall determine and intimate to the Head of Department the number of vacancies to be filled during the course of the year of recruitment as also the number of vacancies to be reserved for candidates

COLUMN-I*Existing Rule*

belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other categories under rule 6. The Head of the department shall also intimate the number of vacancies to the Board and the Government. The vacancies for direct recruitment shall be notified by the Head of the department in the following manner:-

(i) By issuing advertisement in daily newspaper having maximum circulation ;

(ii) By pasting the notice on the notice board of the office or by advertising through Radio/Television and other Employment newspapers;

(iii) By notifying vacancies to the Employment Exchange; and

(iv) By any other means of public communication.

rule 15

4. In the said rules, in the existing rule 15 for clauses (c) and (d) set out in Column-I below, the rule as set out in Column-II shall be *substituted*, namely:-

COLUMN-I*Existing Rule*

(c) **Scrutiny of Documents and Medical Examination.**

(d) **Physical Efficiency Test-**

Candidates found successful in Scrutiny of Documents and Medical Examination as per clause (c) will be required to appear in Physical Efficiency Test, which will be of qualifying nature. As far as possible, the Board will try to conduct Physical Efficiency Test of candidates on the next day of their Scrutiny of Documents and Medical Examination Test. The procedure for conducting the Physical Efficiency Test shall be as prescribed in Appendix-2.

COLUMN-II*Rule as hereby substituted*

belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other categories under rule 6. The Head of the department shall also intimate the number of vacancies to the Board and the Government. The vacancies for direct recruitment shall be notified by the Board in the following manner:-

(i) By issuing advertisement in daily newspaper having maximum circulation ;

(ii) By pasting the notice on the notice board of the office or by advertising through Radio/Television and other Employment newspapers;

(iii) By notifying vacancies to the Employment Exchange; and

(iv) By any other means of public communication.

COLUMN-II*Rule as hereby substituted*

(c) **Scrutiny of Documents and Physical Standards Test.**

(d) **Physical Efficiency Test-**

Candidates found successful in Scrutiny of Documents and Physical Standards Test as per clause (c) will be required to appear in Physical Efficiency Test, which will be of qualifying nature. As far as possible, the Board will try to conduct Physical Efficiency Test of candidates on the next day of their Scrutiny of Documents and Physical Standards Test. The procedure for conducting the Physical Efficiency Test shall be as prescribed in Appendix-2.
