

IN pursuance of the provisions of clause (3) of Article 348 of the Constitution, the Governor is pleased to order the publication of the following English translation of Notification no.2299/VI-pu-1-15-500(50)-2015 dated November 04, 2015:

No. 2299/VI-pu-1-15-500(50)-2015

*Dated Lucknow, November 4, 2015*

IN exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (1) of section 157 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, (Act no.2 of 1974) read with section 21 of the General Clause Act, 1897, Act no. 10 of 1897, and in supersession of Notification no. 7760/6-pu-1-97-27-97 dated September 15, 1997, the Governor is pleased to direct that the Officer incharge of police station may depute the Head Constable (Promotional Pay Scale) to investigate the facts and circumstances of the following cases and if necessary, to take legal action:

- (a) (i) Offences under section-160, 323, 324, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860;
- (ii) Offences of pick-pocketing, theft of bi-cycle, electric wire, Animal theft, committed on railway platform and theft of any other movable property up to the value of Rs. 25000/-;
- (b) offences under Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and Indian Railway Act, 1989;
- (c) Offences under section 25 read with section 4 of the Arms Act, 1959:

Provided that all those Head Constable of Police department who may or may not be getting personal grade pay of Rs. 4200/- will be treated as Head Constable (Promotional Pay Scale) as an exception for one time. This will apply only to presently available Head Constable of Police department:

Provided further that any constable of Police department who will get promoted as Head Constable after the date of publication of this notification in *Gazette*, will be treated as Head Constable (Promotional Pay Scale) after completing 7 years of service as such on the post of Head Constable, including the probation period.
